Our Vacation Care program is available for children aged 5–12 years. Children must have completed at least one full term of school before they can enroll in our Vacation Care program.

Parent Contact Information Requirements

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children attending Vacation Care, all booking forms must be completed in full. Incomplete booking forms cannot be accepted or processed.

Families must provide:

- A current personal contact number
- A current work contact number
- At least one emergency contact number for a person authorised to collect the child if required
- **Parents/Guardians must remain contactable at all times while their child is attending Vacation Care.** In the event of illness, injury, or any situation requiring a child to be collected, a Parent/Guardian or authorised emergency contact must be available to collect the child promptly.

Child Care Subsidy (CCS)

Families wishing to claim CCS must ensure the following steps are completed on enrolment.

- Set up your MyXplor Parent Hub
- Accept your Complying Written Agreement (CWA)
- Confirm your enrolment through MyGov

All of these steps must be completed before your child can attend.

Booking Conditions

Once a booking has been confirmed, fees are payable whether or not your child attends.

Additional days may be requested if vacancies are available. Any requests for extra bookings must be made through the main office. OOSHC educators are unable to accept bookings and will refer families to the office for all booking enquiries.

Outstanding Accounts

Families with outstanding fees owing to Rainbow Children's Centre will be unable to make Vacation Care bookings until their account has been brought up to date. If you have an outstanding balance and wish to

book into the Vacation Care program, please submit your completed booking form to the office and arrange to meet with Jodie or Jayne to:

- Pay any outstanding fees; and
- Pay for your new Vacation Care booking in advance.

Bookings cannot be confirmed until these requirements have been met.

Food and Nutrition

Vacation Care is a busy and exciting day for children. Please ensure your child brings sufficient food and drinks to last the entire day. While we may provide occasional cooking experiences and afternoon tea activities, these are offered as extras and should not replace your child's daily meals.

Electronic Media

At Rainbow Children's Centre, we encourage children to actively engage in sports, games, creative experiences, social interactions and outdoor play during Vacation Care. For this reason, the use of electronic media is kept to a minimum. Computers, Ipads, mobile phones, smart watches will not be available to children. Televisions, videos or projectors will only be used when:

- A specific learning activity has been planned as part of the program; or
- Inclement weather requires children to remain indoors for extended periods.

Children who prefer quieter or more independent activities will always be supported in making appropriate choices throughout the day.

Personal Belongings

Children attending Vacation Care are expected to take reasonable responsibility for their personal belongings. While educators will provide assistance and support where required, we encourage school-aged children to demonstrate increasing independence in caring for their own possessions.

We strongly discourage children from bringing valuable items to Vacation Care, including electronic games, expensive toys or other items that may be lost or damaged in a large group setting.

Any mobile phones, handheld gaming devices or similar electronic items brought to the service must be handed to staff upon arrival for safe storage and will be returned at the end of the day.

Rainbow Children's Centre accepts no responsibility for personal items that are lost, damaged or misplaced.

Secure Your Place Early

Vacation Care places are limited, and bookings are allocated based on priority of access and availability.
